Varsity

Bellaire's season got underway against #11 ranked area powerhouse Brazoswood and the Cardinals made a statement early. Recovering a fumble on the opening kick off only to have their initial drive stall, Brazoswood soon learned they were in for a fight. Bellaire's defense stuffed Brazoswood all night giving up only 4 first downs. The offense relied on 27 carries (89 yards) by sophomore tailback Denzel Evans and appears to be adapting to the new offensive scheme well; in fact, the Cardinals had 5 first downs vs. Brazoswood's 4! But for a couple of mistakes on a fumble and a punt snap, the Cardinals played this game very close. Sophomore Devin Lauderdale sparked great field position on punt return after punt return and junior Melvin McAdams nearly scored on a fumble recovery. It was very clear the Cardinals made a statement in this game and more than a few 20-5A teams took notice.

Subvarsity

The Cardinal JV Black defeated Brazoswood 14-8, while the Gold team lost 27-12. The Cardinal Frosh rolled with the Red team blasting Brazoswood 28-8 and the White team tossing a shut-out 22-0.
