

## Bellaire JV – 32    Houston Austin – 0

The young Cardinals won their second consecutive shut out by defeating Houston Austin 32 – 0. The JV used a crushing ground game to control the ball and amass 222 yards rushing on 34 carries. Christian Dolphus started the scoring on carries of 14 and 23 yards. Dolphus finished the game with 10 carries for 81 yards. Ronald Anafaro was another workhorse carrying the ball 11 times for 74 yards and one touchdown. Quarterback Tyler Aubertin had an excellent game completing 4 out 6 passes. He also had 5 carries for 24 yards and a touchdown on an 11 yard scramble. Dequante Carter had 3 receptions for 28 yards and a touchdown run of 18 yard on a reverse. Beto Garcia added two extra points to round out the scoring. The offensive line of Richard Jones, Michael Abrams, Jonathan Vasquez, Bobby Pringle, Jared Broadway and Ivan Cortez controlled the line of scrimmage.

Defensively, the Cards now have held opponents without an offensive score for the past 13 quarters. Colin Speich, Steven Stricklin, Jonathan Kelly, Lucas Hargett, Shane Sluder, Alec Abell, Reid Jaco, and Greg Shannon led the swarming defense which allowed only 66 yards in total offense to the visiting team.
