

JV Romp to 33-0 Victory over Milby

The JV Cardinal football team destroyed Milby Thursday 33 – 0. The young Cardinals overcame no electricity in the school all week and dressing in the dark to explode in all phases of the game. The defense took front stage in the game allowing the Buffs to minus 37 yards total offense. In addition, the defense accounted for two scores of their own; a safety and a 62 yard interception by Colin Speich to highlight the defensive play. Other defensive standouts were Shane Sluder, Lucus Hargett, Alec Abell, and Beto Garcia.

Offensively the Cards used its strong running game to hammer away at the Milby defense. The offensive line was led by Richard Jones, Jonathan Vasquez, and Michael Abrams. The JV record is now 1 -1 -1.
